NSU Heeds Faculty Requests, Revives Degree Program

Nova Southeastern University's Fischler School of Education and Human Services offers numerous courses online to serve those interested in education worldwide. Its newest addition launched in late August in response to requests from the world of special education.

Dr. Tony Bright, lead faculty on the Doctorate of Special Education and the Cognitive Behavior degree at NSU, explained that research indicates that many education administrators today want to employ teachers with a focus on certain facets of special education. To fill that need in the marketplace, NSU revived and revised a master of science in education with a focus on cognitive and behavioral disorders.
